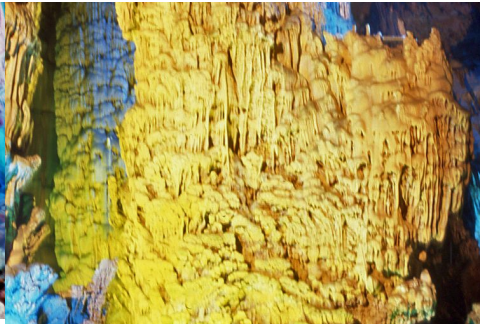


Guilin Visit - Part 2: Local features

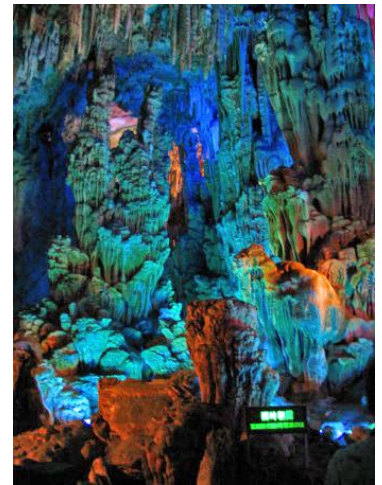

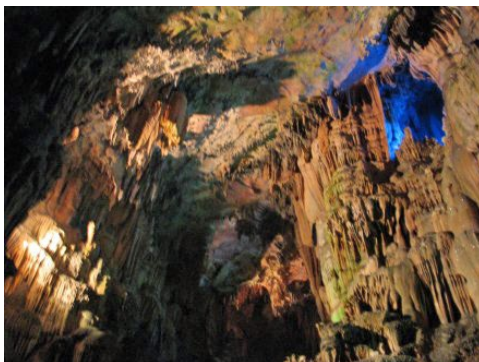
