
8 Nov. 1979. Note all pasture, almost no trees, upper pond only, no bottom drainage line, long distribution lines



3 Oct. 1999. Van Bibber Trail, loop trails present, more farm buildings, bottom drainage to eastern pond, more trees.




22 June 2004. Last view with farm buildings.


30 July 2007. The gray areas in lowlands are barren or weed covered. Some needed black cloth removal. Before soil and



6 Oct. 2013. Most of the light green patches in the lowlands show successful prairie grass plantings, else weed removal.



9 June 2017. The two rich green rectangles in the lowlands are prairie grasses. The green north of the upper pond is from irrigation water in excess of our allowance. Trail moved.



12 Sep. 2019. New parking lot and walkway. The green north of the upper pond shows benefit of normal water release.
