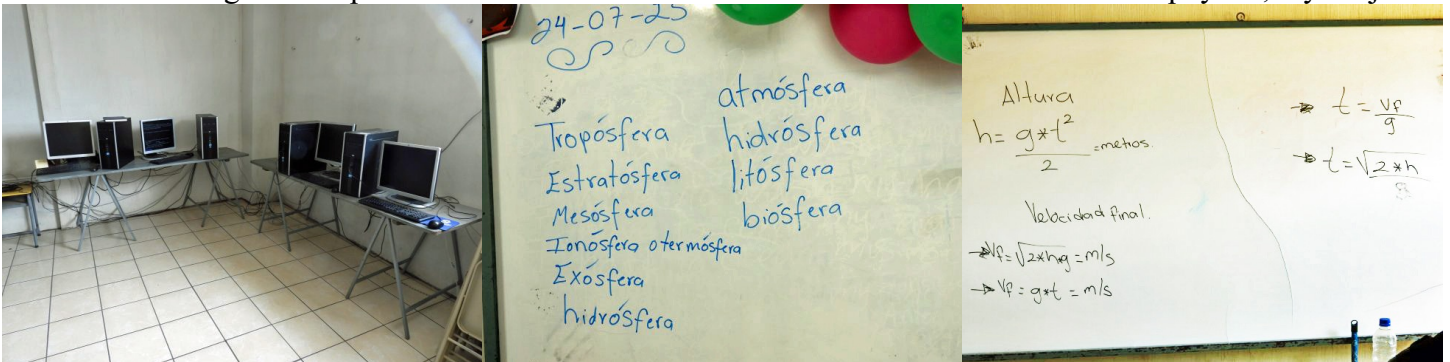
We then entered the church and were introduced to the pastor, son, and wife. We were divided into two groups and given a choice for our tasks for the visit: clean the school windows or play games with the students.
